Besides death and taxes, sometimes it seems the only other certainty is that Polly Ferman's busy performing schedule will be taking her to venues around the world. Highlights of her schedule for the next few months include:

**January 19** - 8pm - **Tango Passion** featuring the Binelli-Ferman Duo with the City Chamber Orchestra of Hong Kong and dancers Pilar Alvarez and Claudio Hoffman. Hong Kong City Hall Concert Hall. **February 20 to March 5** - Recordings with the extraordinary Camerata Romeu and Antonio Peruch, acordeonist in Havana, Cuba.
