Once again, we're here to tell you about Polly Ferman's busy performing schedule in venues around the world. Highlights of her schedule for the next few months, which will be largely centered in South America, include:

**March 27** - The Binelli-Ferman Duo (at right) in concert in City Bell, Argentina



**March 31** - Binelli-Ferman in concert with the UNCuyo Symphony Orchestra in Mendoza, Argentina

**April 10** - Polly will be part of the Notable Pianists concert series in Buenos Aires at the Clasica Y Moderna venue

**May 27, 28, 29** - The Binelli- Ferman Duo with the National Symphony Orchestra of Bolivia, Patricio Augusto Aizaga Villacis, conductor.

Recent engagements have included:

**March 19** - The Binelli-Ferman Duo in concert with guitarist Alvaro Pierri as part of the opening of the spectacular Peninsula Hotel in Shanghai, China.



**February 20 to March 5** - Recordings with the extraordinary Camerata Romeu and Antonio Peruch, acordeonist in Havana, Cuba. Camerata Romeu is an all-woman orchestra, directed by Zenaida Romeu (at left with Polly).
